Dear Fellow Lectors (regular and substitutes),

Advent, Week Two: Advent begins this weekend (1st Sunday of Advent, Nov. 30/Dec. 1, as listed on our last schedule). If you haven't already done so, please remember to pick up your new lector workbook, Gospel of Luke (Year A), from the usher's room (green cover, labeled with your name). If yours isn't there, please let Barb Schenauer in the Parish Center know.

Please review this schedule very carefully due to the holy days/holiday assignments (based on your responses to me as well as entered in Ministry Pro, to serve during this Advent/Christmas season and beyond). This schedule goes until Feb. 23rd, the Sunday before Ash Wednesday. Lent begins Wednesday, February 26, 2020.

Here are a few things to note for this 2019/2020 season:

- The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, December 8th, is on Sunday this year. The Mass for this be on Monday Dec. 9th, 830A. It is not holy day of obligation.
- There will be a 12-Hour Reconciliation Service on Wed. Dec. 12.
- Masses on Christmas Eve Night, Tue. Dec. 24, 430P in the Church and in the PAAC. The 10P Mass is in Church (readings are yet to be determined).
- Masses on Christmas Day (Wed. Dec. 25): 830A & 1030A (readings are yet to be determined).
- Masses for the Holy Family, Dec. 28/29, Sat. 430P; and Sun. 730A, 9A, and 11A. Readings are in our workbook (pages 35-38)
- Mary, the Holy Mother of God (New Year's Day) is a holy day of obligation. There will be three Masses: Tue. Dec. 31, 430P; Wed. Jan. 1, 830A and 1030A Readings are in our workbook (pages 39-41).

Remember that you are responsible for your participation in this ministry; therefore, you must continue to use Ministry Pro from now on, as all schedules are being handled there. Remember to list your "Service preferences" for one or all the Masses you usually attend, this includes all substitutes as well. Without this preference, otherwise you'll be scheduled wherever the program sees a blank spot.

Also, remember that preparing yourself to proclaim the Word of God at your assigned Mass, as well as finding a substitute, or switching with someone, if you cannot serve as assigned. Kindly and prayerfully review the enclosed list of service opportunities for Lent 2020 and return by email or hard copy to the lector box by February 2, 2020 (subject to change based on Ministry Pro). Thank you for your prayer-filled and heartfelt participation in the Lector Ministry.

Notes for Lectors

Arrival Time: 10-15minutes before start of Mass.

Please sign in by initialing next to your name on the Schedule in the Sacristy (posted on the upper left of the bulletin board). Review your reading in the Lectionary, as well as the petitions. Ask the Presider to clarify anything, if necessary.

1ST READER:

- Carries the Book of Gospels in the procession (unless a deacon is present).
- Holding the Book of Gospels – left hand on binding and right hand on opening; this is not backwards, it is so the congregation can see the front cover as you process by and is easily put into the book stand on the altar (if the stand isn't there, lay the book flat).
 - You do not bow with the Book of Gospels.
- Hold the Book of Gospels up so the lower edge is just above your eye level (somewhat equal to your eyebrows)

2ND READER:

- Puts the lectionary in place on the ambo five (5) minutes before Mass begins, open to the First Reading.
- Puts the Lectionary in the ambo shelf after conclusion of 2nd reading.
- Leads the congregation in the Universal Prayer (unless the deacon is present)
- Approaches the altar during the end of the Creed to be at the ambo before the Presider's begins
- Reads each petition/intercession clearly and sincerely. Remember to turn to the presider when he is speaking.
- Remain at the ambo until the congregation says, "Amen."

BOTH READERS:

- Bow each time you enter and leave the altar, from the center.
 - Please sit along the center aisle, within the first six rows.
- Coordinate your entrance and exit with the cantor (this is still a work in progress)
 - As the 1st reader leaves the ambo, the cantor is to come to the altar so you can bow together.
 - As the cantor leaves the ambo, the second reader comes to the altar so you can bow together.
- Adjust the microphone before you turn it on.
- Remember to leave the ribbons in their places in the Lectionary.
 - If the ribbon is in your way, slide it to the center of the book.
- Remember to pause after the Introduction "A reading from..." – *pause* – Proclaim the Reading – *pause* – "The Word of the Lord" – remember to wait for the congregation's response before leaving the ambo [*pause should be a slow count to three*]
 - Engage the congregation while proclaiming, from beginning to end. Don't turn off the microphone or put the lectionary into the ambo shelf until the congregation has said, "Thanks be to God."
- Returns the Lectionary and the Book of Gospels to the sacristy after Mass
