Reading: A Reading from the Letter of St. Paul to the Romans (Romans 14: 7-9)

Both in life and death, we are the Lord's. That is why Christ died and came to life, that he might be Lord of both the dead and the living.

The Word of the Lord. Response: Thanks be to God.

Psalm Response: Psalm 130

Refrain: (Lord, in your steadfast love, give them eternal life!)
